

This morning, with our organ out of commission for maintenance, we offer our worship music on the piano.



Partita in B flat major BWV 825:

Originally the 17th century name for a single piece of music, the *partita* evolved into a collection of pieces in the late baroque. Often a set of dances, the name is interchangeable with *suite*.

J.S. Bach's Clavier-Ubung (translation: keyboard exercises) contains six partitas. To call them "exercises" in the sense of a student keyboard exercise both vastly underemphasizes the challenge of playing them and shows the high level of expectation from old Johann's students. We hear a gentle and cleverly composed Prelude based on a recurring stepwise ascending ornamented passage, a Sarabande (a slow dance that evolved from Spanish music), plus two minuets. Capping off our partita today is the quintessential way to end a suite— a lively

Stained Glass Window Restoration Project





In the coming weeks and months, Rubaiyat Stained Glass Studio will be restoring and preserving nine stained glass windows in the Sanctuary and front entrance of Grace Church. Windows will be removed one at a time and reinstalled when repairs are complete. Each window is expected to take from eight to 16 weeks.

 Specialist. The Session expressed its gratitude for the faithful work of so many

- closed with prayer, remembering especially those who are grieving, facing health challenges and those who are celebrating



Engagement and Service Spotlight

Single Use Disposable Cups

It might seem harmless to stop at your local coffee shop and grab a coffee to go; but have you considered the impact of that choice? Did you know that 500 billion disposable coffee cups are used globally each year? It equates to 20 million trees and 3.7 billion pounds of waste generated each year to produce the cups.

Quite sobering, isn't it? That a simple coffee cup could have such an effect? Every minute, 1 million single use coffee cups are sent to the landfill. Canada discards over 1.5 billion disposable hot drink cups annually.

Robert Swan said that "the greatest threat to our planet is the belief that someone else will save it". Our choices have an impact. With that in mind, we'd like your help to change the amount of disposable cups we use at Grace.

For the next two weeks, we will have "Idea Boxes" at each coffee station during fellowship hour. Please bring forward your ideas for how we can move away from using disposable cups.
