Music Notes Matt Kallio

Good morning! Well, after much hullabaloo our organ is finally functional again! Many thanks to Leslie Smith and his team of organ builders as well as Chellan and Steve Hoffmann for doing a quick tuning post-repair. It's so very good to have our beloved instrument back and supporting our music ministries here at Grace!

Our prelude music is some beautifully contemplative music from Alexandre Guilmant's compendium "L'Organiste Practique". Guilmant was an important organist of the French romantic school in Paris. He studied with the famous organist Jacques Lemmens and wrote almost exclusively (and very prolifically) for his instrument. While his output for other instruments or ensembles is much less, trombonists will recognize his famous solo piece "Morceaux Symphonique", a staple of that instrument's repertoire.

Our offertory is a fine little piece based on the 19th century hymn tune by Annie Hawkes and Robert Lowry arranged by James C. Casey. "I Need Thee Every Hour" was written in 1877 in Brooklyn, New York by the hymn writing duo. It has a characteristic easygoing singable melody of American hymnody of that time. One verse is as follows:

I need Thee ev'ry hour, Most gracious Lord; No tender voice like Thine Can peace afford.

Thursday, July 27 marked the 110th anniversary of the dedication of Grace Presbyterian Church. To mark this significant milestone, the Stewardship Committee, with the support of Session, initiated a campaign to engage the congregation in the repair and restoration of nine stained-glass windows in the Sanctuary and front entrance.

Work is underway and over the next several months, Rubaiyat Stained Glass Studio is repairing and restoring the stained-glass windows, one at a time.

We will spend an hour in a group session followed by a time of fellowship as we enjoy lunch together. We look forward to welcoming you.


