## **Grace Presbyterian Chancel Choir**

The chancel choir is a mixed voice ensemble, soprano, alto, tenor and base (SATB) and is comprised of both professional and amateur singers. The choir provides music for Sunday services at Grace as well as performing concerts and special events throughout the season. The focus is music from the classical canon—Renaissance, Baroque, Classical and Romantic works—as well as contemporary music. The ensemble meets for rehearsals from September to June on Thursdays at 7:30 pm.

### **Grace Notes Children's Choir**

This season, we will focus on our children's choir. All children from the Grace congregation and community, aged 7 years and older, are welcome. The choir will build basic music skills and will join the Grace Choir in services for special times of the year such as Easter, Christmas, all-ages services and special events.

### **Grace Band**

Grace's music ministry is starting an instrumental group. We are offering an open call for all musicians—all string types, woodwinds, brass, and any other instruments. The Grace Band will meet bi-monthly to rehearse and prepare music for services and other special events. Amateur, professional or somewhere in between, come and see what we are about as we connect over the challenge of classical sacred music. We will have a place for you!

### **Grace Handbell Choir**

The first practice of the Handbell Choir is September 11. Our handbell choir has long been part of our ministry. We are inviting new members to this challenging but fun musical expression. Welcome to Grace. We are excited to have our chancel choir back from their summer break. I know I can speak for all in the congregation that we've missed their ministry over the summer months. Welcome back choir!

Joining us as well in our anthem and other music during the service is our own Grace congregation member Jennifer Frank on French horn. We are very much looking forward to presenting our music with her.

Our anthem this morning is an exciting piece by America composer Dr. Paul Basler based on the text of Psalm 96. Dr. Basler has held positions as a Fulbright Senior Lecturer in music at Kenyatta University (Nairobi, Kenya) and the University of Florida where he teaches composition and horn. In "Sing to the Lord" Basler creates a bouncy sense of excitement with the 6/8 meter and constant 3 note figurations in the right hand of the piano while employing expansive harmonic writing.

## **Minister Resource Update**

- While the Search Committee is working diligently to find our next Lead
  Minister, Session has instructed the Interim Moderator, Minister Resource and
  two additional Session Elders, to review our ministry model and determine the
  number of ministers that will serve Grace and develop their respective position
  descriptions.
- The recommendation is that Grace will be best served by two full-time
   Ministers of Word and Sacrament, rather than 3.1 full-time Ministers. The team
   would be a Lead and an Associate Minister.
- Rev. Jake Van Pernis has been included in these discussions and is supportive of the changes. The committee has been careful to ensure the key responsibilities of our four-minister model will be included in the new model, and that Rev. Jake Van Pernis' position will continue to equip the congregation to fulfill our mission of loving our neighbours and effecting social change.
- Next Sunday, September 17 you are invited to discuss the proposed changes with our Interim Moderator, Rev. Dr. Jean Morris, after worship in the boardroom. The following Sunday, September 24, other Elders will lead the discussion.
- This week, you will receive a letter and the proposed position descriptions to clarify the roles of the two ministers.
- If you cannot stay after worship, you are encouraged to speak with your Elder or send your comments to the Clerk of Session, Len Wolstenholme at clerk@gracecalgary.org or Rev. Dr. Jean Morris at jeanmorris@platinum.ca.
   Your thoughts will be helpful in finalizing the model prior to its final consideration by Session and Presbytery.
- Again, these changes will not slow or otherwise impact the work of the Search Committee.



### **Mission Moment**



Pakistan is the world's third-largest refugee host country, accommodating over a million Afghans who fled their homes due to war, internal conflict, insecurity and persecution. The poorest refugees lack sufficient access to necessities such as food, shelter, clothing and health care. Another need expressed by Afghan refugees is for their children to be able to access schooling. PWS&D is responding to this need by providing a digital learning facility where Afghan refugee children and young women can access virtual education in place of traditional schools. The Digital Learning Center is



one way of supporting those who have already lost so much. It is planting the seeds for current and future success for children and young women who would otherwise be entirely out of school.
