Music Notes

Matt Kallio

Good morning Grace! Two Renaissance composers for our prelude and postlude this morning with a lovely anthem by Nancy Weider, arranged by Jay Althouse.

Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina is most famous for being a master of choral writing in the High Renaissance. He did not write much organ music but we are fortunate that some of it was arranged for playing on the organ from existing choral scores. The Cantantibus Organis is one such work. Imitative writing abounds just as in any other piece in this 16th-century style. Similarly, we have Jan Pieterszoon Sweelinck's toccata. Sweelinck definitely wrote for the organ (as well as choirs and many other instruments). He was considered one of the most important composers from the Netherlands school.

Finally our anthem is a tuneful little meditation on trusting in the steadfast love of God. The opening words are "God is always with me, He is here beside me, ever in my heart and in my life." The composer, Nancy Weider, lives in Emmaus Pennsylvania where she is active as a musician and teacher's aide. The arranger, Jay Althouse, has written choral music for all ages and levels of school and church choirs with over 450 compositions choral compositions and arrangements in print!

Bulletin - Financial Update for August 2023

(Monthly updates will now be shared in the bulletin as well as the newsletter and website.)

Positive trends continue in August. The operating deficit for August is \$168,000 less than budget and \$54,000 less than the same period last year. While revenues are approximately \$22,000 less than 2022, there are positive trends in individual components of the revenue stream (noted in the full monthly report posted on the website—see the link below). For comparative purposes, the revenues in April of 2022, included a sizable contribution by a donor. A similar contribution was made in April 2023; however, the donor restricted the use to capital expenditures. Therefore, it will not show up in revenues until it is used. Expenditures are \$226,000 less than budget and \$54,000 less than the same period in 2022.

Minister Resource Update

- While the Search Committee is working diligently to find our next Lead Minister, Session has instructed the Interim Moderator, Rev. Dr. Jean Morris, Minister Resource Committee, and two additional Session Elders, to review our ministry model and determine the number of ministers that will serve Grace and develop their respective position descriptions.
- The recommendation is that Grace will be best served by two full-time Ministers of Word and Sacrament, rather than 3.1 full-time Ministers. The team would be a Lead and an Associate Minister.
- Rev. Jake Van Pernis has been included in these discussions and is supportive of the changes. The committee has been careful to ensure the key responsibilities of our four-minister model will be included in the new model, and that Rev. Jake Van Pernis' position will continue to equip the congregation to fulfill our mission of loving our neighbours and effecting social change.
- You will have received a letter describing the recommendation, the proposed position descriptions clarifying the roles of the two ministers, and key messages about the proposed change. These three documents were sent by email and to Grace's mailing list. If you did not receive the documents, please email <u>office@gracecalgary.org</u>.
- Today, September 24 you are invited to discuss the proposed changes with our Elders after worship in the boardroom
- If you cannot stay after worship, you are encouraged to speak with your Elder or send your comments to the Clerk of Session, Len Wolstenholme at <u>clerk@gracecalgary.org</u> or our Interim Moderator, at <u>interimmoderator@gracecalgary.org</u>. Your thoughts will be helpful in finalizing the model prior to its final consideration by Session and Presbytery.
- Again, these changes will not slow or otherwise impact the work of the Search Committee.

Session Highlights

At its regular meeting on September 11, 2023, the Session:

- reflected upon times of transition and liminality, as described in Acts 9:1-22, as well as parts of Susan Beaumont's book "How to Lead When You Don't Know Where You're Going", and prayed for Grace Church
- considered the proposed Ministry Model and minister position descriptions, and received comments from Service Elders
- directed further work to address harassment concerns
- discussed the ministry of Preaching Grace and provided feedback for the committee on strengths and opportunities
- approved updates to the Roll, which now stands at 377 professing members, in addition to 162 adherents, and agreed to proceed with communications seeking renewed engagement of some members
- agreed with the plans for the Wednesday mornings grief group
- edited the strategic plan, going into its final year, to reflect learnings over the last year, adding emphasis to engagement with the Anyuak and South Sudanese communities within Grace, leadership development, stewardship, and furthering a culture of caring and respect
- considered possible changes to the Committee structure, with further discussion to come
- approved an increase in the Music Coordinator's work hours from 22 hours per week to 30, for the remainder of the employment contract (September 2023 through January 2024)
- celebrated all the baptisms on August 13
- approved the appointment of the Church School leaders
- agreed to sign a long-term investment pooling agreement with The Calgary Foundation for the investment of the Grace Legacy Fund
- decided to establish an ad hoc committee to develop a comprehensive strategy for real estate for Grace
- received updates on the workplans of the committees, Communications Specialist, and Coordinator of Volunteers, and reports from the Interim Minister (the Rev. Wendy Adams), the Interim Moderator, the Representative Elder, and the Support Services Director
- received and discussed various correspondence
- closed with prayer
