Music Notes Matt Kallio

Music from many eras in history accompany our world communion day service. Our prelude is by the great German composer Felix Mendelssohn. Having written a great deal of organ music for the church and concert hall, his organ sonatas are bread and butter for organists when it comes to Romantic era repertoire. In the Adagio we hear today (the second movement of the sonata op. 65), Mendelssohn creates a serene mood with the long lines and melodies typical at the time.

Continuing in the Romantic era vein, we present English composer Edward Elgar's *Ave Verum* from his op. 2 set of motets. *Ave Verum* is an excellent choice for communion anthem, the words translated:

Hail, true Body, born of the Virgin Mary,

truly suffered, sacrificed on the cross for mankind,

from whose pierced side water and blood flowed:

Be for us a foretaste in the trial of death!

O sweet Jesus, O holy Jesus, O Jesus, son of Mary, have mercy on me. Amen.

We also present the communion motet *O Sacrum Convivium* by the Italian Renaissance composer Lodovico Viadana, a teacher, composer and Franciscan Friar in the Order of Friar's Minor Observants. Translated the text is:

O sacred banquet! In which Christ is received, the memory of his Passion is renewed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory to us is given. Alleluia.

Finally, we end the service with *Postlude in D major* by Anglo-Canadian organist/composer Healey Willan. Well known in Canada as one of our most important sacred musicians, Willan has written extensively for the church. He had a distinguished career at several churches but most notably at St Mary Magdalene in Toronto, a post he held until a year before his death in 1968.


