This anthem is quintessential Rutter, warm, almost neo-romantic in its approach and very accessible.

I love a good chorale prelude, and today we begin worship with a favorite of mine, Anglo-Canadian composer Healey Willan's serene take on the above mentioned tune "Slane". Willan marked this chorale prelude as "Slane - at the close of day" and I can see why, it evokes a peaceful atmosphere with the string stops and gentle solo stop, however, I believe it also works beautifully as a prelude.

Session Highlights:

At its regular meeting on October 10, the Session:

- prayed for peace, justice and reconciliation in Palestine and Israel, remembering
 Ephesians 2:11-22, and reflecting upon The Presbyterian Church in Canada's
 statement of solidarity with all the people of the region (https://presbyterian.ca/2023/10/10/a-relentless-cycle-of-conflict-inflicting-immeasurable-pain-and-suffering/)
- considered the implications of times of liminality for church leaders, as described in Susan Beaumont's book How to Lead When You Don't Know Where You're Going, when leaders are encouraged to have incarnational presence and a presence of awareness
- celebrated the partnerships that resulted in meaningful National Truth and Reconciliation Day events at Grace, and the commissioning of Pastor Olul Ojulu Owiti and Achwol Omot Omot as they begin their mission work in Gambella
- received updates on and directed further actions to address workplace harassment concerns
- agreed upon steps to address some misunderstandings about the fixed term employment of the Music Coordinator
- approved the formal ending of the Parish Nurse Program, with many thanks for the service of Sherry Buckle, Sierra McNamara, Nancy Mazereeuw, Liz Sarginson, and Robin Tomlinson. Staff are being certified in first-aid.
- agreed to establish a Leadership Development Committee and a standing Stewardship Committee, as well as some changes to the mandates of the other Committees, consistent with the refreshed Strategic Plan. Terms of Reference and workplans are to be adjusted accordingly.
- initiated the process for recruitment and election of Ruling Elders, to be complete in the spring of 2024
- discussed the preliminary draft of the 2024 budget, with adjustments to be incorporated in a revised draft for consideration at the November 13 Session meeting
- supported plans for a congregational meeting on December 10, at which approval of the 2024 budget will be sought
- encouraged the work of the Ad Hoc committee work leading to a comprehensive land and building strategy, and directed next steps to address the recent correspondence with RESET about Grace House

Session Highlights continued

- agreed with plans for a Memorial Worship Service to be held in the Chapel on November 1, and for Christmas Eve Services at 10:30 am and 7:00 pm
- was advised that the Presbytery had approved the revised 2 minister model and the associated position descriptions
- received updates from Spiritual Growth, Pastoral Care, Engagement & Service, Governance & Planning, Human Resources, Facilities, Finance, Preaching Grace, Lead Minister Search, the Interim Moderator, and the Interim Minister
- received and discussed various correspondence as required
- closed with prayer for individuals, the Grace congregation, and world leaders in the face of so much suffering

September 2023 Financial Report

Positive financial trends are continuing in September. The operating deficit for September is \$147,000 less than budget and \$65,000 less than the same period last year. Revenues are on par with 2022. Expenditures are \$195,000 less than budget and \$64,000 less than the same period in 2022.


