A candidate has been invited to preach for the call on February 4. A letter from Interim Moderator, The Rev. Dr. Jean Morris, and a Preach for the Call document explaining the process, the roles of members and adherents and the timeline have been emailed and mailed to all members and adherents of Grace Presbyterian Church. These documents are also inserted in the bulletin and posted on the Grace website at www.gracechurchcalgary.com.

 Candidate meets with Session and Service Elders; The Rev. Jake Van Pernis; and members of staff.

- Congregation is invited to meet the Candidate between 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm at Grace Presbyterian Church. The candidate will speak briefly at 2:45 pm.

Sunday, February 4: Worship, followed by Congregational Meeting, then Signing of the Call.

The candidate will preach for the call. Everyone is strongly encouraged to attend in-person. If you cannot attend in-person, please view livestream worship, or watch the recorded video at: www.GraceChurchCalgary.com/worship/.

Congregational Meeting (immediately after worship). Attend in-person or online via Zoom—email office for Zoom link.

- Worship: Candidate leads worship.
- Congregational Meeting: members vote to extend a call.
- If successful, members and adherents sign the call document.
- Signatures collected until February 20.
- Call is presented to Presbytery Calgary-Macleod. If approved, it then goes to candidate's Presbytery.
- Candidate has 10 days to accept.

New Elder Districts:

We have recently re-assigned elder districts to ensure that all members and adherents have an elder. There is a list of individuals in the congregation, with their elder, printed on an insert in the bulletin. Elders are contacting people in their districts to remind them to attend the events of The Preach for the Call weekend. Should the congregation vote to call this minister, elders will be seeking your signatures between February 5 and 19. The number of signatures indicates the strength of the congregation's commitment to call this minister, so it is very important that every member and adherent make the effort to sign the call. Music Notes:

Good morning, Grace Presbyterian Church! Our prelude this week is a lively toccata by Johann Pachelbel (you may be noticing a lot of Pachelbel pieces cropping up in the services; that's because Matt got a new book of Pachelbel organ music at Christmas). The toccata originated from early Italian organ playing where it was originally improvisation to test out a keyboard instrument, the word toccata coming from the Italian "toccare", meaning to touch. The toccata evolved to playing various figurations, scale patterns and sequences to try out the instrument. Eventually, the improvised music was written down into formal compositions, as we moved towards the baroque period in music history. The form has flourished with toccatas being written still in modern day.

Our anthem today uses one of our hymn tunes "O Master Let me Walk with Thee" (tune: Maryton). Its author, Washington Gladden (1836-1918), was called to the First Congregational Church in Columbus, OH in 1882, remaining there for 32 years. In 1883-84 he was known for his success in fighting the corrupt Tweed Ring, for arbitrating the Telegraphers' Strike and the Hocking Valley Coal Strike. He challenged John D. Rockefeller, Sr. for giving \$100,000 of "tainted money" to the Congregational Church's Foreign Missions program. Throughout his ministry he emphasized applying the gospel to life in America. He wrote "O Master, let me walk with thee" in 1879.

Session Highlights:

At its regular meeting on January 8, 2024, the Session:

- opened with a reading from Romans 12
- gave thanks for the growing numbers of volunteers, new worshippers, and students in the English Language Learner program
- prayed for individuals who are ill and dying, and their loved ones
- considered the key points from Chapter 5 of Susan Beaumont's Leading in a
 Liminal Season focused on "rightly remember[ing] stories from the past, so that
 these stories teach important values for the present and shape a hope-filled
 future"
- heard, with grateful hearts, from the Lead Minister Search Committee on its work and approved the committee's unanimous recommendation that the Session invite a candidate to preach for the call on February 4
- reviewed the process that is required leading up to, during and following the call weekend February 2-4. Communications from the Interim Moderator with the congregation starting immediately.
- approved the list of members and adherents to be shared with the congregation, along with the names of their elders, January 21
- received reports from the Interim Ministers and referred the matter of the position description of the Support Services Director to the Minister Resource & Presbytery Relations Committee
- was advised that there are currently several individuals in discernment about serving as a ruling elder
- referred proposed communications to professing members who have not been active for some time to the Pastoral Care & Connection Committee
- agreed that the Human Resources Committee be made inactive, with its responsibilities distributed to Minister Resource & Presbytery Relations, Governance, and Leadership Development (when established) Committees
- approved updated Terms of Reference for the remaining Committees and workplans for some of the Committees
- received additional reports on the work of the Engagement & Service, Spiritual Growth, and Land & Facilities Committees, the Coordinator of Volunteers, and the Communications Specialist
- was reminded to register for the Preaching Grace weekend February 23-25 with the Rev. Dr. Richard Topping
- closed with prayer and a benediction


