

Welcome to Chris and Kim Joiner

Grace is very pleased to welcome the Rev. Dr. Christopher Joiner to preach for the call as Lead Minister. Dr. Joiner is currently serving as Minister of First Presbyterian Church in Franklin, Tennessee. Chris and his wife Kim are at Grace for the weekend to meet the congregation and continue their discernment of a call. Chris' full bio is in the insert.

Music Notes:

We have some beautiful music planned that includes our chancel choir and Camerata instrumental group assisted by Wayne Hubbard on organ. We open with a trio sonata by German baroque composer Georg Philip Telemann performed by members of Grace Camerata Group. Telemann was one of the most famous composers of his day, eclipsing even J.S. Bach, who was more known as an organ virtuoso than a composer. One famous story is that Telemann and Bach were applying to a major church for the same position of Kapellmeister (music leader). The church authorities were excited to have the famous Telemann applying for the position. In the end, Telemann accepted another opportunity, and, the church grudgingly decided to go with the second-choice candidate, J.S. Bach, a relative unknown at the time!

Today's postlude is by the French Romantic-era composer Theodore Dubois. After study at the Paris Conservatoire, Dubois won France's premier musical prize, the Prix de Rome, in 1861. He served as organist and choirmaster at several wellknown churches in Paris, and at the same time was a professor at the Conservatoire, teaching harmony from 1871 to 1891 and composition from 1891 to 1896. Bright and cheerful, with running sixteenth notes in the right hand, his toccata is an accessible and satisfying closing piece.




