

#### **Music Notes:**

The anthem sung today by the choir is an appropriate choice for Lent in its quiet mood, gentle rhythms and Lenten text. It is by well-known American sacred music composer Dr. Eugene Butler, recipient of various honors, such as Kansas Composer of the Year and the coveted ASCAP Standard Music Panel Award, every year since 1972, as well as the Outstanding Alumnus Award by the University of Missouri-Kansas City in 1983. Currently Dr. Butler is retired and keeps busy as a choral adjudicator and workshop clinician.

Our prelude today is a voluntary by English classical composer John Stanley. While not a household name, Stanley was nevertheless a well-respected organist and composer in 18th century London. Studying under Maurice Greene, also a well-known musician, he developed into a brilliant organist and violinist. He was good friends with many of the luminaries in London at the time, including George Frederic Handel, who was often seen listening to Stanley playing at London's Temple Church where he held the post of organist.

One of my favorite hymn tunes, SLANE, is being sung today! SLANE is an old Irish folk tune associated with the ballad "With My Love on the Road" in Patrick W. Joyce's Old Irish Folk Music and Songs (1909). It became a hymn tune when it was arranged by David Evans and set to the Irish hymn "Be Thou My Vision" published in the Church Hymnary (1927). SLANE is named for a hill in County Meath, Ireland, where St. Patrick's lighting of an Easter fire—an act of defiance against the pagan king Loegaire (in the fifth century)—led to his freedom to preach the gospel in Ireland. Today's postlude is also based on this tune, composed by young, up and coming organist Paul Fey.
