Music Notes:

Good morning, Grace Presbyterian! Today we have our Grace Handbell Choir joining us in some beautiful Lenten music. Welcome handbells! We are using the Lenten tune "Herzliebster Jesu" in two of our pieces today. Often translated into English as "Ah, Holy Jesus" or sometimes as "O Dearest Jesus", "Herzliebster Jesu" is a Lutheran Passion Hymn in German, written in 1630 by Johann Heermann, in 15 stanzas of 4 lines, first published in Devoti Musica Cordis in Breslau. As the original headline reveals, it is based on Augustine of Hippo; this means the seventh chapter of the so-called "Meditationes Divi Augustini", presently ascribed to John of Fécamp.

Our anthem today has an interesting compositional choice, an organ pedal drone ostinato, written to simulate the plodding steps that Jesus took on his way to crucifixion. See if you can hear it— it creates a powerful musical effect.
