Music Notes

Worship service is full of great music this morning! We are fortunate to have two of Grace's music ministry groups joining us today, Grace Handbells, as well as Grace's Camerata instrumentalists. We begin with a beautiful arrangement for bells of the tune "In Dir is Freude" (In You Is Joy), a 1591 tune from Germany, followed up by J.S. Bach's sonata for two flutes and continuo, BWV 1039, played by Grace Camerata.

The anthem, sourced from W.A. Mozart's "Litaniae de venerabilialtaris sacramento" K. 125 was edited and condensed by Hal Hopson and set to new English words. Originally this music was a Kyrie movement, part of a litany to venerate the Eucharist. While arranged from the original, it still contains the usual Mozartian beauty in melody and classical symmetry. Finally, the handbells will play an evocative setting of the French 15th-century Easter tune "O Filii et Filiae" more commonly known to us as "O Sons and Daughters Let us Sing", written for organ and handbell choir. Thank you to lan Charter for his assistance conducting the bells today.



It's an insightful resource for those looking to understand the nuances of Middle Eastern history, the personal stories that reflect larger communal narratives, and read about reconciliation efforts.

Presbyterian World Service and Development Mission Moment

Sydney Nkhata, a 27-year-old from Northern Malawi, is the chair of a youth network made up of 12 clubs. His management journey was significantly influenced by the "Every Youth Empowered" project, which provided valuable leadership training and is funded by PWS&D.



Equipped with new skills, Sydney has become a mentor—guiding and nurturing club members. His efforts ensure that youth actively embrace and take ownership of the project, where they learn about sexual and reproductive health rights—turning it into an integral part of the community. As a result, girls and boys are more aware of the risks related to early pregnancies and transmission of diseases and are changing behaviours. Sydney's story highlights the transformative power of leadership training and showcases his commitment to mentorship and community development.
