### **Music Notes**

The music at Grace on Pentecost is filled with themes of spirit, wind and fire. The prelude by J.S. Bach is a popular choice for Pentecost. Bach uses Martin Luther's "Come, Holy Spirit, Lord God", placing the chorale tune in the pedals, and then uses the manual or upper notes to weave notes together to sound like rushing wind.

The anthem is the rollicking spiritual "Every Time I Feel the Spirit". This sacred music favourite dates to before the American Civil War and has been recorded countless times by many artists. The arrangement today is by American composer, conductor and organist Jack Schrader.

## **Session Highlights**

At its regular meeting on May 13, the Session:

- opened with prayer and a reading of 2 Chronicles 5, reflecting on the glory of God filling our worship spaces
- welcomed the three new elders serving on the Session
- approved the practice of locking the west and east doors at 10:45 a.m., the
  north door at 11:00 a.m., and the south door after worship on Sundays, to
  increase safety. Signage will be enhanced, directing worshippers arriving later, to
  the south door
- agreed to have 2 weekday events and a worship service in June to acknowledge the renewal of the Chapel as a space for worship, mission, and ministry, to the glory of God
- celebrated the news of the planned arrival of the refugee family originally sponsored in 2019. Funding was approved and volunteers will support the settlement of the family
- approved position descriptions for the Music Director and the Organist, and the mandate for the search committee to be initiated by June 1
- approved a revised position description for the Support Services Director and provided guidance on the goals for the next 6 months
- gave thanks that all members and adherents are now assigned an elder and committed to the work to ensure this is sustained
- expressed its gratitude for the deep commitment of Mary Lil Rozsa de Coquet in her service as Representative Elder to Presbytery. Appointed Mary Jardine as the Alternate Elder from Grace
- was reminded of the leadership retreat on June 14/15
- encouraged the various committees in their transitioning with new leadership
- was pleased with the gifts from Grace to The Rev. Chandra Mannix in recognition of her ordination
- closed with prayer, giving thanks for the presentations on the pastoral aspects of Medical Assistance in Dying that was provided to all the elders
