Music Notes

There are two Communion-themed works in the service: Harold Friedell's beautiful anthem "Draw us in the Spirit's tether" and an expressive setting of Psalm 34:8 "O Taste and See" by Timothy Flynn for the Offertory.

The postlude is "Liebster Jesu, wir sind hier" (Dearest Jesus, we are here), a Lutheran hymn with text written by Tobias Clausnitzer in 1663. The tune is based on a 1664 melody by Johann Rudolph Ahle. J.S. Bach takes this tune and embellishes it in the soprano solo stop of the organ, causing it to take on a new life.
