Music Notes

In recognition of National Indigenous Sunday, Grace welcomes Wendy Walker, sharing traditional music of her culture. We are grateful for her contributions to Grace's worship.

Healey Willan, an important and prolific voice in 20th-century Canadian sacred music, composed the Postlude. When the Order of Canada was established in 1967, this honour was given to Willan. In Britain, it was customary for the Archbishop of Canterbury to occasionally grant very distinguished English cathedral musicians the Lambeth Doctorate, Mus. D Cantuar. In 1956 Willan, "the Dean of Canadian composers," became the first non-English church musician to be so honored.

Session Highlights

At its meeting on June 10, 2024, Grace's Session:

- read the Luke 10:38-42 story of Mary and Martha, and reflected on how the Session might choose "the better part", as did Mary, and opened with prayer
- welcomed Chris Joiner as a guest
- celebrated the relationships growing with newly assigned members in elders' districts, the joy of the recent baptism, the milestone of an upcoming 100th birthday
- noted its deep gratitude for the wise service of Jean Morris in her role as Interim Moderator, as it draws to an end with the induction of Chris Joiner on June 23
- was advised that an experienced consultant will work with the team as Chris begins his leadership role
- gave thanks for the ministry of Geoffrey Simmins at Grace which ends June 30
- received an update on the Music Ministry Search Committee (Shirley Philips-Convener, Elizabeth Cressman, Doch Diok, Jennifer Frank, CK Okongwu, Andrea Radford, with the Ministers) as it begins its work
- appointed Joanne Kellough, a Session elder, as Roll Clerk
- approved, with delight and thanks to God, the reception of 19 new members plus 3 confirmands
- agreed to revisions to the roles of the Deacons of Bereavement Care, Hospital and Health Care, and Homebound Visitation and approved the position description for a Deacon of Welcome and Hospitality
- agreed to remove 6 members from the roll, as the individuals have not responded to repeated efforts to reconnect
- approved revisions to the Terms of Reference for Ad Hoc Committee for Elder Election, and dismissed the most recent Ad Hoc Committee, with thanks
- considered feedback from the exit interviews of two Session elders as they completed their service on the Session
- approved the work goals of the Support Services Director for the next six months
- agreed to re-establish a Human Resources Committee, with new Terms of Reference

- requested the Financial Management Committee to recommend an investment policy by September
- noted the need for additional communication with the congregation on giving trends
- received updates from the ministers, including a high level statement of account for the disbursement of Pastoral Funds, and reports from the staff and the majority of the committees
- gave thanks for David Caldwell's faithful service over 27 years as both a Session and Service Elder.
- acknowledged with gratitude the tremendous work of volunteers in the programs at Grace
- prayed for the congregation and members facing bereavement and illness, for Chris and Kim Joiner as they make their new home in Calgary, for the Leadership Retreat, for Sabbath rest as programs take a summer break, for new members as they profess their faith, and for existing members as they seek to better know Christ and glorify God.

MISSION MOMENT June 16, 2024

Am Salama reflects on her life in Sudan before the outbreak of war. Following a political crisis in 2023, she and her family, once prosperous farmers and restaurant owners, were forced to flee their bustling town in East Darfur due to escalating tensions. The war separated Am Salama from her husband, who stayed behind to care for his blind mother. Facing numerous challenges during their journey to South Sudan, including being robbed of the little money and clothing she had managed to bring with her and frequent illness, Am Salama and her children found refuge at the Wedwil Refugee Camp. The safety and food assistance they received at the camp, supported by PWS&D, played a critical role in their survival.
