Ephesians invites us to consider the mystery and majesty of God's will and way for Christian believers, the church, and the world.

Human Resources Committee

The Session has agreed to re-establish a Human Resources Committee, with an updated mandate of: Ensuring the implementation of The Presbyterian Church in Canada's safety policies and Grace's human resource policies as they relate to employees, staff, and contractors, and ensuring the alignment of policies with applicable legislation. The expectation is that the Human Resources Committee will meet quarterly, and will work with an HR consulting firm. Three members from the congregation with an interest in human resources are needed to serve on this committee.

Deacon of Welcome and Hospitality

The Deacon of Welcome and Hospitality is a new volunteer role meant to help strengthen Grace's ministry of welcome, support Grace's team of welcomers, and ensure connections with newcomers. This Deacon is required to be present for most Sunday worship services, and will work collaboratively with Grace's ministers, staff, and volunteers to help identify ways for Grace to model Christian hospitality.

Engagement & Service Committee

The Engagement & Service Committee welcomes additional members to bring vision and skills to the variety of community service and social justice partnerships and programs the Engagement & Service Committee oversees. Current Engagement and Services initiatives include operating the Satellite Food Bank, supporting newcomers through the English Language Learners program, co-sponsoring a refugee family, and encouraging environmental stewardship. This Committee typically meets by Zoom on the evening of the 4th Monday each month.
