#### **Music Notes**

On World Communion Sunday, Grace's choir will share a familiar favourite piece while communion is being served, the spiritual "Let Us Break Bread Together". This spiritual has its roots in coastal South Carolina, and more generally, along a stretch of the U.S. east coast known as the Gullah Geechee Cultural Heritage Corridor, named after its dialect. Originally the song was sung by slaves using the underground railroad, and has since made its way into many hymnals as a communion song.

Grace also welcomes flautists Jin Lee and Paul Xu. They will be playing two movements from classical era German composer Johann Vogel's Sonata for two flutes in addition to American organist and composer Gordon Young's Elegy from his triptych for flute and organ.

Sign up now to attend the Lebel Lecture in Christian Ethics on Friday, October 11 from 7:00 p.m. -8:30 p.m. hosted by the Chair of Christian Thought at the University of Calgary and the Calgary Public Library at the Patricia A.
