Music Notes

The prelude for worship is by the Czech composer Jan Zach. Zach was born in Bohemia and in 1724 he moved to Prague to work as violinist. There he studied organ and his career as organist started at the Church of St. Martín. By 1737 Zach was also playing the organ at the Monastic Church of the Merciful Brethren and the Minorite Chapel of St. Ann.

Zach's work reflects the transition from the Baroque music style to the emerging Classical music era ideals, with influences of Italian composers.

The opening hymn takes its melody from the famous choral section of Ludwig van Beethoven's Symphony number 9 in d minor. Beethoven's final symphony was an innovation especially in that it included a section sung by the choir. The original words reflected Beethoven's belief in the kinship of humanity.

Session Highlights

At its meeting on October 15, the Session:

- worshipped together, reflecting on Mark 10:17-22 and the text's meaning to us as leaders at Grace and as individuals
- gave thanks for the study on John 20 and 21, led by the Moderator of the 2024 General Assembly, the Rev. Dr. Pat Dutcher-Walls on September 30, as The Presbyterian Church in Canada considers narratives of Hope and Possibility for the denomination
- welcomed the Treasurer, who presented the current year financial trends, and the preliminary budget for 2025. September year-to-date finances are better than at the same point last year. The budget will be finalized and recommended to the congregation for approval in late November/early December
- received a presentation from the Convener of the Land and Facilities Committee on current activities and future plans. Potential projects are being scoped and will be prioritized based on 1. Life and Safety (including accessibility), 2. Maintenance, and 3. Improvements. The congregation will be invited to support these projects when better defined
- discussed suggestions for use of the proceeds of the sale of Grace House. These
 will be considered as the strategic plan is refreshed in the coming months
- approved the Investment Policy proposed by the Financial Management Committee
- appointed Shirley Philips as Land and Facilities Committee Liaison, as Janet Hyde has taken a leave of absence
- named Jennifer Williams as Deacon of Welcome and Hospitality, to provide leadership in further strengthening Grace's intentional welcome and integration of newcomers
- accepted the transfer of membership to Grace of Dr. Terence and Susan White.
 The Roll now stands at 350 professing members, and there are 162 adherents
- approved the baptisms of David Ojulu, Tekajwok Ojulu, Deborah Meer Ochala and Sarah Meer Ochala
- received reports on the many programs and initiatives overseen by the Committees
- closed with prayer and a benediction
