Music Notes

On this Reformation Sunday, the music selections are from two composers.

Johann Pachelbel (1653-1706) is well known in the world of music as an important figure in the Baroque period. Many do not know that he was also a prodigious composer of church music. The prelude is his choral partita on "Ach, was soll ich Sunder machen?" (What shall I, a sinner, do?) The chorale partita takes a well-known hymn of the time and presents variations based on that tune.

The postlude is a fantasia written by Michael Praetorius (1571-1621) based on the quintessential Martin Luther tune "Ein Fest Burg" (A Mighty Fortress). A fantasia is an improvisatory keyboard work. In the piece, Praetorius cleverly weaves the hymn tune throughout the work, creating a powerful and satisfying setting of this beloved tune.
