## **Music Notes**

A prevalent tune starting the Advent season is the ancient plainchant "Veni, Veni Emmanuel", more commonly known as "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel." The hymn is a metrical paraphrase of the *O Antiphons*, and has its origins in monastic life in the 8th or 9th century. The metrical form of the hymn in Latin was composed as early as the 12th century. The prelude, offertory, opening hymn and postlude all use this beloved tune.
