### Jubilee: Gospel Love & Justice

The Hebrew Law provided for a year of Jubilee every 50 years. In this year all debts were to be forgiven and all prisoners set free. It was to stand as a sign of God's steadfast love and grace and a mark of God's intention that the world be free. As far as we know, Israel never initiated a Jubilee Year, but it stood in the Law as a longing and a promise. Jesus declared in Luke that the year of the Lord's favour—the Jubilee—was found in him. Through this season we will explore passages in Corinthians and Luke that lift up the shape of Jubilee—God's love and justice, God's liberation of all creation in Jesus Christ. As Grace celebrates 120 years of ministry this year, let us pray that God will make this a Jubilee for us and for our community.

### **Music Notes**

Composer and organist Sir Charles Villiers Stanford's *Prelude in G major* opens service today. Stanford (1852-1924) was a music teacher, and conductor of the late Romantic era. Among his pupils were rising composers whose fame went on to surpass his own, such as Gustav Holst and Ralph Vaughan Williams. Stanford composed a substantial number of concert works, including seven symphonies. His best-remembered pieces are choral works and organ pieces for church performance. Stanford is most famous for the oratorio "*The Crucifixion*".

The *Trumpet Tune* by German organist and composer Paul Fey (b. 1996) closes service today. Fey is a prolific and youthful composer who writes accessible, tuneful and practical pieces for liturgical use. Fey is one of the organists at the Thomas Kirche (St. Thomas Church, Leipzig, Germany), the former post of J.S. Bach.

# **Grace Updates**

### **Gambella Mission Project**

In the Fall of 2023, after 20 years of living as refugees in Calgary, Reverend Olul Owiti, minister to Grace's Anyuak Community, and his wife Achwor Ojulu returned to Ethiopia's Gambella State with the help of Grace Presbyterian Church to lead training workshops for ministers and spouses at the invitation of the East Gambella Synod of the Ethiopian Evangelical Church Mekane Yesus.

This trip led to a recognition that there is a significant need for capacity-building within the East Gambella Synod, its 8 presbyteries, congregations, and leaders due to many previous Anyuak church leaders having fled Gambella or in some cases killed by divisive violence. However, a new and committed group of leaders has emerged, needing ministerial and leadership training.

The Engagement & Service Committee has approved funds for Reverend Olul and Achwor to return to Gambella from January 27 to March 29, 2025, to again provide minister and leader training by conducting two workshops during a five day training from February 2-7, hosting small group and individual meetings with ministers, travelling through Gambella state to visit churches as well as lead worship, address staff and students at the Mekane Yesus Seminary, as well as meet with government officials.

Rev. Olul will also be speaking with leaders of the East Gambella Synod to develop a 3–5-year plan to support the churches in its 8 presbyteries, develop partnerships, and expand collaboration with partners.

During the time Rev. Olul and Achwor are in Gambella, Grace will receive updates and will be sharing information from these updates through the bulletin. These updates will include prayer requests and information about trainings and meetings.

Please pray for the Spirit's travelling mercies and inspiration as Rev. Olul and Achwor travel to Gambella.
